FROM THE DESK OF PASTOR RON

Sometimes people come across our path that are already involved in the Lord's work and we seek to help them continue what the Lord is doing through them.

The council agreed last month to adopt a Ride Tough Ministries led by one of our new members, Cory Wilson and I wanted you to hear about this ministry.

Ride Tough Rodeo Ministries is an outreach to the bull riders, and saddle and bareback riders of the Kansas, Oklahoma, Texas, Colorado, and Nebraska region, as well as the larger western community that exists through the Facebook page.

I physically attend rodeos and serve behind the bucking chutes with a cooler with iced water bottles, bibles, and a small tool kit that has small essentials for the rodeo cowboy (Advil, wrenches, dog biscuits, nail files).

I work to build ongoing relationships with these young men. At rodeos I will pray with them, and often afterwards discuss spiritual matters, and offer counseling. The rodeo happens to be a fraction of what the ministry is in total. I'm able to stay in touch and communicate with many of the young men on a daily basis year round. We discuss who Jesus is, daily life, and how to grow with the Lord to become the men that he's designed them to be.

In 2016 Ride Tough Rodeo Ministries drove 11,000 miles between Fathers day and labor day, distributed 2,500 bottles of water, packed in 450lbs of ice.

Ride Tough also has a substantial Facebook presence. On the page I'm able to post short devotionals as the Spirit leads to write, updates from rodeos, etc. The internet allows it to be a truly international ministry. I've heard back from as far away as Brazil. Cowboys on a Crow Reservation in Montana have also taken to using the Facebook writing as bible study material.

Many of those Ride Tough serves whether in the rodeo community, or larger western community, live in areas that are sparsely populated, and they don't have access to a regular church body like the one we're blessed with.

Matthew 28:19 tells us to go to all nations making disciples, and that is the aim of Ride Tough Rodeo Ministries, to go to this nation of people, with His guidance, serve them, love them, lead them to salvation, and disciple so that they can continue the work until He returns for his children.

The Lord loves these people, and I'm seeing Him work in the rodeo and western community. I'm humbled that He'd use me to be a part of his mission.
