STEWARDSHIP THOUGHT "EXTENDING THE GOSPEL"

And He said to them "Go into all the world and preach the gospel to every creature." (Mark 16:15 (NKJ))

"Jesus spoke the words of the above text in the imperative mood. The command is "Go ... preach" everywhere! Through the world outreach of the church, it is possible for all of us to obey this command. Because of our modern missionary program, all of us can have a share in the work both here and abroad through the giving of our money.

When we compare our giving for the world mission of the church with that which we spend on secular interests, it should disturb us greatly. In April, the Unified Budget giving of \$12,036 exceeded the actual expenditures by \$315. Budget giving has exceeded the actual expenditures in each of four months of 2016 for a total of \$2391. The total giving for the Kodiak Baptist Mission children's summer ministries was \$830 which is great way for us to reach out beyond our local church.

For every contribution given towards the Unified Budget, a portion of it goes towards supporting local and world missions of the church. Every year we have three special American Baptist Church offerings and other special mission projects that support missions throughout the world. Thanks to all those who have contributed towards these offerings and the Unified Budget. May God bless each of you as we work together to support the world mission of the church so that the message of Christ may be preached everywhere. – Rich McCullum
