# Plumbing

I really hate plumbing. There are few things in this world that I hate but plumbing is one of them. I imagine that somewhere there is a version of hell in which your job is fixing toilets 24-7. There are several principles of plumbing that I have discovered that make it so undesirable. The first principle is that you can almost never estimate the amount of time and effort a job is going to take. At our house in California we had galvanized pipe that was 30 years old. I noticed a small lead on the main line going into the house and rubbed my finger across the area that was leaking and it began to spew water. This began the process of digging up the whole line and replacing it. The second principle is that the piece of PVC pipe that you measured and cut will be determined to be too short between 5 and 10 seconds after you have cut the pipe. This is all to say that plumbing reminds me that we live in a fallen world where lots of things go wrong but at the end of the God makes all things good and we appreciate more when things run smoothly and our water and plumbing works. I look forward to the day when God sets all things right, rights all wrongs, and we get to spend eternity with Him. I just sure hope that my job in heaven has nothing to do with plumbing.
